## Fankerton Legend Fankerton In Fankerton I

Fankerton has an estimated population of 195 and has increased by 31.8% in the last 10 years. 64.6% of people are of working age and 19.5% of people are aged 65 and over. Fankerton is estimated to have 93 households. The vacancy rate (1.7%) of dwellings is lower than the Falkirk rate of 2.3%. 0.2% of households are exempt from paying Council Tax and 29.4% have a single adult Council Tax discount.

There are no areas within the most 20% deprived Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation in 2020.

Examining the different types of benefits, there are a lower number of Carers per 1,000 population in Fankerton (7.38) compared to the Falkirk rate of 17.67 per 1,000 population. Those claiming Disability Living Allowance is higher (14.76 per 1000) than the Falkirk rate of 9.45 per 1,000.

Unemployment figures are lower in Fankerton with 5.0% unemployed compared to the Falkirk rate of 8.2%. Female unemployment is lower (1.4%) than the Male rate (3.6%).
