
## Profile



Letham has an estimated population of 283 and has increased by 134.8%% in the last 10 years. 63.9% of people are of working age and 9.6% of people are aged 65 and over. Letham is estimated to have 119 households. The vacancy rate (2.4%) of dwellings is higher than the Falkirk rate of 2.3%. 0.3% of households are exempt from paying Council Tax and 24.0% have a single adult Council Tax discount.

There are no areas within the most 20% deprived Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation in 2020.

Examining the different types of benefits, there are a lower number of Carers per 1,000 population in Letham (14.69) compared to the Falkirk rate of 17.67 per 1,000 population. Those claiming Disability Living Allowance is higher (19.27 per 1000) than the Falkirk rate of 9.45 per 1,000.

Unemployment figures are lower in Letham with 3.6% unemployed compared to the Falkirk rate of 8.2%. Female unemployment is lower (1.4%) than the Male rate (2.5%).
