
Profile



Rural Falkirk has an estimated population of 3,449 and has increased by 28.4%% in the last 10 years. 63.5% of people are of working age and 17.6% of people are aged 65 and over. Rural Falkirk is estimated to have 1,504 households. The vacancy rate (2.0%) of dwellings is lower than the Falkirk rate of 2.3%. 0.5% of households are exempt from paying Council Tax and 26.5% have a single adult Council Tax discount.

There is 1 are within the most 20% deprived Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation in 2020.

Examining the different types of benefits, there are a lower number of Carers per 1,000 population in Rural Falkirk (8.93) compared to the Falkirk rate of 17.67 per 1,000 population. Those claiming Disability Living Allowance is higher (21.42 per 1000) than the Falkirk rate of 9.45 per 1,000.

Unemployment figures are lower in Rural Falkirk with 4.0% unemployed compared to the Falkirk rate of 8.2%. Female unemployment is lower (1.6%) than the Male rate (2.3%).
