
Profile



Slamannan has an estimated population of 1,378 and has increased by 3.4% in the last 10 years. 63.4% of people are of working age and 15.8% of people are aged 65 and over. Slamannan is estimated to have 589 households. The vacancy rate (4.6%) of dwellings is higher than the Falkirk rate of 2.3%. 0.6% of households are exempt from paying Council Tax and 36.1% have a single adult Council Tax discount.

There is 1 area within the most 20% deprived Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation in 2020.

Examining the different types of benefits, there are a higher number of Carers per 1,000 population in Slamannan (30.88) compared to the Falkirk rate of 17.67 per 1,000 population. Those claiming Disability Living Allowance is higher (64.99 per 1000) than the Falkirk rate of 9.45 per 1,000.

Unemployment figures are lower in Slamannan with 8.0% unemployed compared to the Falkirk rate of 8.2%. Female unemployment is lower (3.1%) than the Male rate (4.5%).

School attendance is 69.1%. 5.3% of 16-19 year olds are not in full time education, employment or training. 5.2% of 17-21 year olds have entered full time higher education.
