
## **Profile**



Stenhousemuir has an estimated population of 9,635 and has decreased by 4.1% in the last 10 years. 62.6% of people are of working age and 21.00% of people are aged 65 and over. Stenhousemuir is estimated to have 4,431 households. The vacancy rate (1.4%) of dwellings is lower than the Falkirk rate of 2.3%. 1.4% of households are exempt from paying Council Tax and 36.2% have a single adult Council Tax discount.

There i 1 area within the most 20% deprived Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation in 2020.

Examining the different types of benefits, there are a lower number of Carers per 1,000 population in Stenhousemuir (14.44) compared to the Falkirk rate of 17.67 per 1,000 population. Those claiming Disability Living Allowance is higher (35.40 per 1000) than the Falkirk rate of 9.45 per 1,000.

Unemployment figures are lower in Stenhousemuir with 4.0% unemployed compared to the Falkirk rate of 8.2%. Female unemployment is lower (1.6%) than the Male rate (2.6%).
