Scottish Parliamentary Election 2016

This insight contains the latest (2014) estimates of the Scottish Parliamentary constituency total population within the Falkirk Council area. The total population of the Falkirk Council area is 157,640 (NRS mid-year estimate 2014).

Introduction

The Falkirk Council area is split between Falkirk East and Falkirk West Parliamentary constituencies. National Records of Scotland (NRS) publishes a yearly population estimate. The Falkirk West estimate population is 79,154.
