Household projections - 2016 based

Insight

The 2016 based household projections show an increase in the number of households in Falkirk from 71,072 in 2016 to 82,073 in 2041, an increase of 11,001 or 15.5%.

Introduction

In July 2018 National Records of Scotland (NRS) published their 2016-based household projections for each local authority area in Scotland. These update the previous 2014-based projections published in 2017.

The 2016-based household projections cover the period to 2041 and provide a breakdown by five different household types:

- one-adult household without children
- two adults without children
- three or more adults without children
- one adult with one or more children
- two or more adults with one or more children

It is important to emphasise that these projections only provide an indication of what might happen if past trends continue.

The average household size in the Falkirk Council area was above the Scottish average in 2016. The projections suggest this will continue throughout the period to 2041. Average household size in Falkirk will decline from 2.22 to 2.07 persons per household while the Scottish figure will fall from 2.17 to 2.02. This means that by 2041 there are expected to be only just over two people, on average, in each household. The main influence on this fall in average household size is the rapid growth of single person households. Average household size is calculated by dividing the number of people living in households by the total number of households.

Single adult households without children are projected to grow from 23,857 in 2016 to 30,668 in 2041, an increase of 28.5%. Single adult households are the largest household type in Falkirk.

The household count from 2016 to 2041 is projected to increase 15.5% in Falkirk and 13.0% in Scotland as a whole.

The population count is projected to increase 8.1% in Falkirk and 5.3% in Scotland.

The contrast between the larger increases in the numbers of households against the smaller increases in population in Falkirk and across Scotland is due to the continuing fall in average household size. This is because more people live alone, there is an increase in single parent households, and the number of large households is decreasing.

The households headed by someone aged 75+ is projected to see the largest percentage increase (80.9%) in Falkirk and (72.2%) in Scotland as a whole from 2016 to 2041.

The greatest percentage increase in households from 2016 to 2041 is predicted to be in Midlothian where an increase of 36% is forecast. Falkirk has the 10th equal highest projected percentage increase across the period (15.5%).
