Life Expectancy 2015-2017



Insight

This insight summarises the life expectancy at birth, and at age 65, for the period 2015-17 for the Falkirk Council area.

Introduction

In December 2018 the National Records of Scotland (NRS) published the life expectancy at birth, and at age 65, figures for Council areas and NHS Boards areas in Scotland for 2015-17.

Life expectancy at birth is the number of years that a new-born baby would live if s/he experienced the particular area's age and sex specific mortality rates throughout his/her life. The measure of life expectancy at birth is a useful way of illustrating how survival rates in an area have changed over time and how it compares to other areas.

Life expectancy at age 65 gives the number of years a person at that age can expect to live, assuming that age-specific mortality levels remain constant.

Falkirk Council falls under Forth Valley NHS Board area.

Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation (SIMD) 2016 ranks small areas in Scotland (datazones) from the most deprived to least. We list the life expectancy at birth in the most deprived area (first quintile) through to the least (fifth quintile).

Falkirk has almost the same life expectacy as Scotland as a whole for males and females, with males being slightly higher by 0.17 years and females lower by 0.57 years. There has been a reduction in life expectancy from 2014-16 for both males (-0.06) and females (-0.10) in Falkirk.
