Introduction

The current nine multi-member Wards were introduced in Falkirk in May 2017. National Records of Scotland (NRS) publish small area data for Council areas - Falkirk has 214 datazones. These figures have been used to estimate the latest Ward data.

The Ward boundaries show Ward 6 - Falkirk North has the largest population (14.0%), followed by Ward 4 - Carse, Kinnaird and Tryst (13.3%). The Ward with the smallest population is Ward 8 - Lower Braes (9.6%).

Dwellings fall within a Council Tax band (A-H). The Band with the highest percentage in Falkirk is Band A (29.9%), followed by Band B (26.1%).

The type of dwelling with the highest percentage is Flats (29.9%), followed by Terrace (23.7%).

The number of rooms in dwellings with the highest percentage is 3 rooms (35.7%), followed by 4 rooms (31.4%).
