

Insight

This Insight contains the latest estimates of the population of settlements within the Falkirk Council area in 2017. The total population of Falkirk is 160,130. This is an increase of 750 (0.47%) from the 2016 estimate.

Introduction

National Records of Scotland (NRS) published small area population estimates for the 214 datazones in the Council area in August 2018. These figures have been used by the Performance and Research team to estimate the population of settlements in the Falkirk Council area in 2017.

NRS calculated the 2017 population estimates for all Council areas in Scotland in April 2018.

NRS revised the 2014 population estimates and these were published in August 2016.

The population of the Council area has increased each year since 1994.

Population change 2014-2017

The population of the Council area has increased since 2014, but the distribution has changed. Whilst some areas have grown in population others have decreased.

The population change 2014-2017 data shows the figures for population change in settlements over 1,000 people (data for smaller settlements is insufficiently reliable to show change over a short period of time). This shows that Redding, Reddingmuirhead, Larbert and Maddiston were the fastest growing settlements due to new house building in these places.
