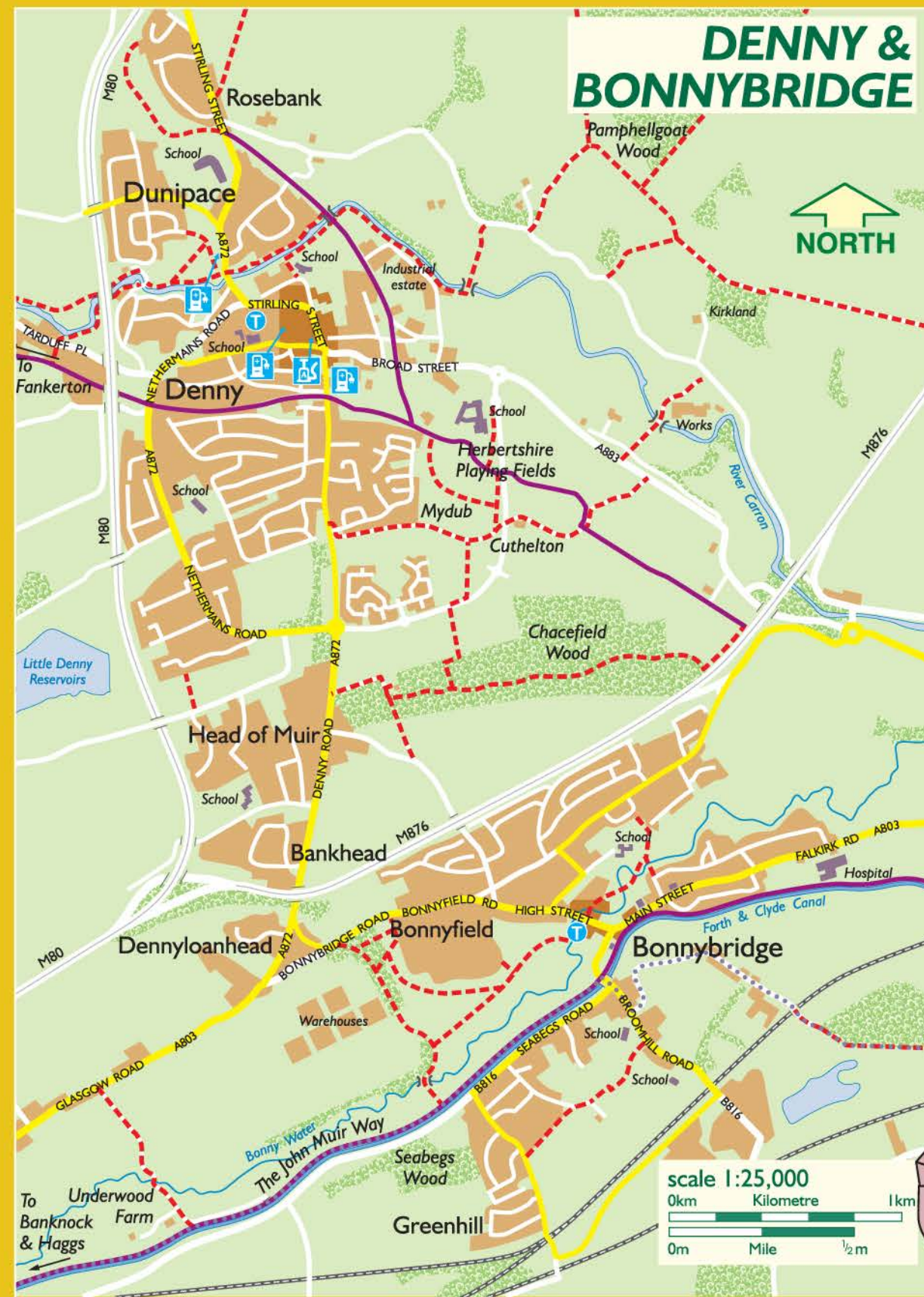
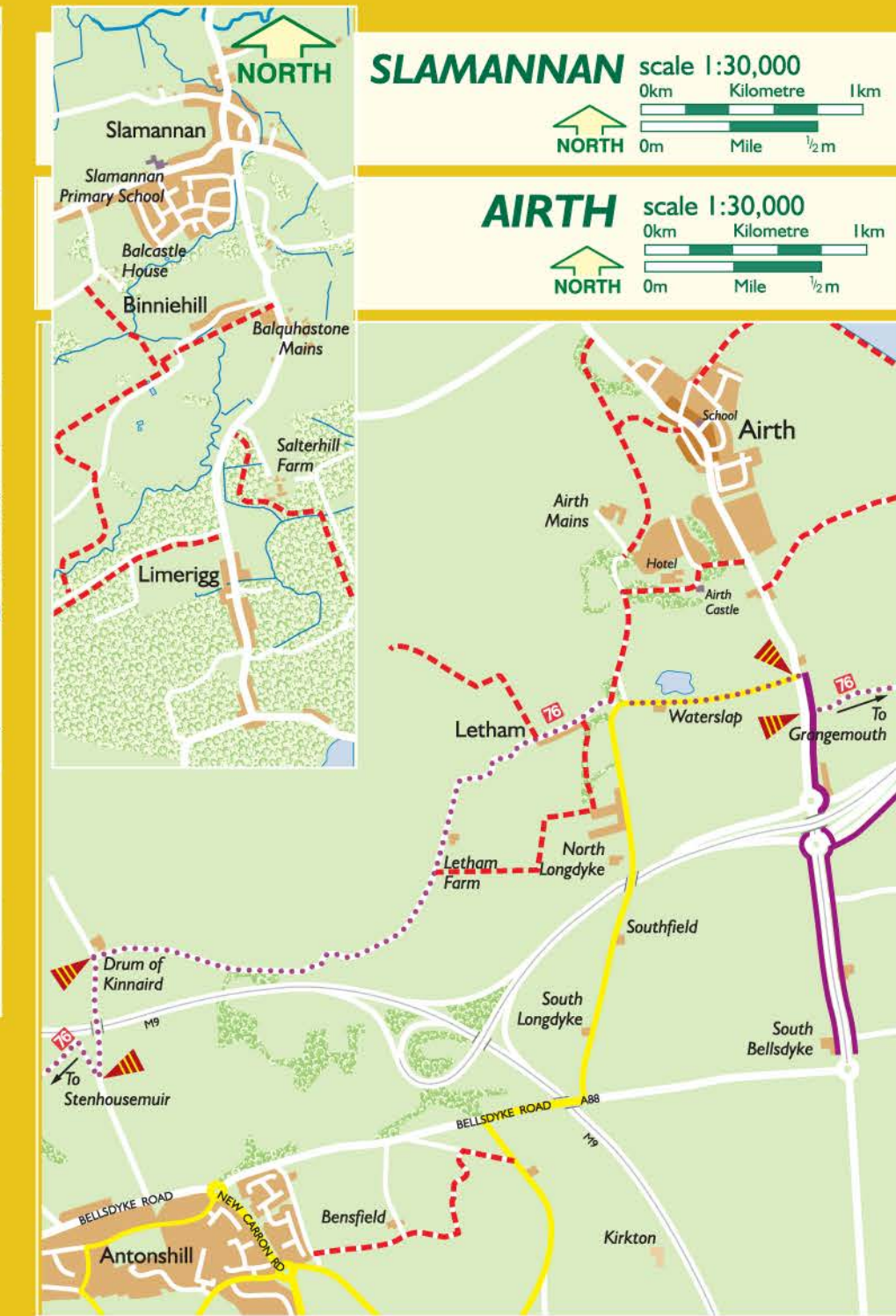

Cycling

Two wheels can be quicker and cheaper than four! Cycling is one of the best ways to keep fit, and can be twice as quick as driving over short journeys. There are mountain bike trails, high quality parkland routes, canal paths and the Round the Forth cycle route. There is something for everyone from beginners to experienced cyclists.

Electric Vehicles

EV charging infrastructure is growing throughout Scotland and the rest of the UK. The Map shows the locations of publicly accessible EV chargers throughout the Falkirk Council area, each of which can charge two cars at the same time.

A ChargePlace Scotland access card or phone app is required to access the chargers, which can also be found at www.chargeplacescotland.org.

Walking

The Falkirk area is officially the best place to walk in the UK, winning the Ramblers Best Walking Neighbourhood Award 2019!

There are over 600km of well signposted and maintained paths offering a quick, healthy and free way to get around the local area. You don't need special equipment or clothing, and even 15 minutes brisk walking is good for your health.

The Green Travel Map also shows the locations of publicly available bike pumps if you need them when you're out and about.

The map highlights routes which are suitable for walkers and cyclists, including cycle paths and canal towpaths amongst others. Bus routes, railway stations and electric vehicle charging points are also shown.
